

MNLOT Risk Management & Risk Assessments

These are assessments of local risk designed to keep you safe by evaluating processes or equipment that might pose harm to workers or visitors to the project.

All users must take responsibility to eliminate potential hazards.

There will be a designated Risk Management Officer. A Committee member.

Risk Assessments will be kept in a folder on the premises for all to view.

If there is an incident, or a new concern or change needing fresh consideration, the Risk assessment will need to be updated.

Record the incident in the Incident Book.

Inform the Chair & the Risk Assessor, or another committee member if there is a major risk asap.

An assessment will be done & any necessary action taken & the team informed.

Any volunteer can and should raise any concern at any time.
